When you travel with Cuba Buddy, we make sure you're aware of Cuba's customs rules. You'll know exactly how much alcohol, tobacco, or other goods you can bring into the country. If you're carrying more than \$5,500 in cash, we help you with the declaration process.

Hassle-Free Return with Cuban Souvenirs

Returning home with Cuban souvenirs is easy with Cuba Buddy guiding you through the customs process. We make sure you know exactly what you can bring back without encountering any issues.

- Cuban cigars: You can take home up to 50 cigars or 200 cigarettes duty-free, but make sure to keep your receipts if you purchase more. U.S. citizens are not allowed to bring Cuban cigars into the U.S.
- Alcohol: Travelers can bring up to 5 bottles of alcohol, but again, always have a receipt from a Cuban store if you're taking more than the allowed limit.
- Souvenirs: Clothing, artwork, and other retail goods are typically permitted within reasonable limits. However, remember to check your home country's import restrictions.
